\*In our Simple Cremation and Memorial Service options there is no embalming and only a very limited time that the deceased may be transferred out of refrigeration and identified. So that the deceased remains in an essentially refrigerated state, we respectfully request that the identification be for no more than 15 minutes from the time we agree to begin. In the interest of full disclosure while minimizing movement of the deceased, the identification occurs in the container that will shelter the deceased prior to cremation and will be later consumed in the cremation process. The fee for this scheduled Goodbye is included in the Simple Cremation with Final Goodbye. In the case of Autopsied remains, embalming is necessary (additional fee).

## Whole Body Donation

*F*or those wanting a cost-free solution or simply wish to contribute to science for altruistic reasons, we offer a “No Cost Cremation” option through our association with whole body donor organizations. Physicians, researchers and educators are reliant on the generosity of donors and their families to conduct the most realistic research possible. The body is then cremated and the ashes are returned to the family in a timely manner.

We are local experts in the “No Cost Cremation” option involving donation and are well versed in the process. We also understand the urgency for those choosing this option because of financial need.

Once the initial call is made to Corbett Funeral Service and the donation option is requested by the legal next-of-kin, we will connect the family with the donor program of their choice; one best suited to their wishes and with the highest probability of acceptance, given the person’s medical and social history.

*Corbett Funeral Service will also:*

- Make the removal from place of death
- Acquire all necessary authorizations
- Coordinate efforts with the donor organization chosen by the family
- Arrange for transportation to the donor organization
- File the death certificate
- Submit notice or obituary (local newspaper charges may apply)
- Arrange for the timely return of cremated remains
- Create an original web page for the life story of the deceased
